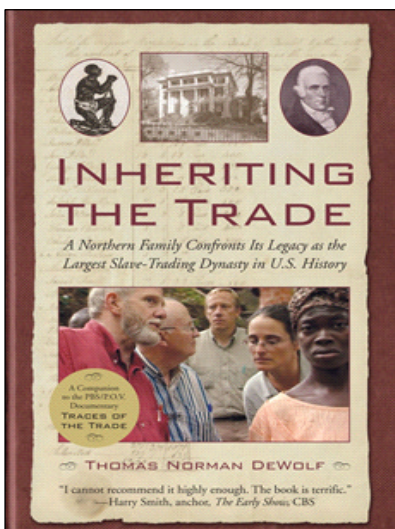


Santa Clara County Black Infant Health Program Advisory Board Presents:
